Sponsorship for the 2020 Ch show has been agreed with Royal Canin and a request for Sponsorship of the other two shows has been sent to CSJ.

Various queries have been sent by members and were discussed. Replies to all were agreed.

A microphone and speaker system will be available at the AGM.

Rosettes will only go down to 3rd place due to low entries in recent times.

Discussion items added to the AGM agenda were discussed and will be further investigated where possible.

The 2020 Champ Show judge has withdrawn due to family ill health. And the new judge is awaiting KC approval. Birmingham National have notified us of the rules for the day. The Vet's availability for the show will be confirmed.

Paul McPherson has been contacted re eye testing at the 2021 show and a local vet has been suggested.

As per our rules, Sue Brookshaw is to be asked if she wants the appointment for 2023.

Five applications for membership have been received and were approved.
